Sessions on Day Two Highlight Health Care, Tech Industry & Air Service

We hope you had a great time connecting with other participants and learning more about Salt Lake City yesterday. Thank you to **Baird** for sponsoring last night's reception at the Edison House. Today's sessions will feature panel discussions on the city's tech industry and health care, as well as a presentation on air service – one of the key drivers of business recruitment.

Our opening panel will discuss the Evolution of Tech in Salt Lake & Utah. Salt Lake City's tech industry continues to attract people from the west coast. In 2022, the city had about 67,500 tech jobs, an increase of 12% since 2019 and more than the 7.3% average growth nationally.

Then, we'll hear about the Huntsman Cancer Institute, a nationally recognized cancer hospital and research center and benchmark institute for the UK Markey Cancer Center, during a panel discussion on health care that will include both Salt Lake City and Lexington leaders. Concluding the day's sessions will be a presentation on air service and how communities can impact the flights offered.
